

We have received requests for information for the Park 131 project. Below are the questions received along with a response.

Q. Can the sidewalk along Lexington be closed along with construction site in temporary fence for duration of project?

A. Yes, closing the sidewalk along Lexington adjacent to the project is acceptable. Utilizing the parking spaces along the project site on Lexington is also permissible. Main St. sidewalk should remain open; temp partial closure ok. Vehicle travel lanes to remain open. Plan to install signs indicating the sidewalk is closed. Alley access may need to remain open, temp or daily closing might be acceptable – coordinate with businesses.

Q. Will any project signs be required for this project? If so, how many?

A. No project signs are required.

Q. Several attempts to contact M-W Containers about hook up details and we have received no response.

A. M-W Containers is the basis for design. Something similarly sized with similar features will be acceptable. Details/options beyond what are in the bid documents will be discussed after award. ***Additionally – due to feedback from potential bidders and a cursory review of feedback available online, M-W Containers should be used as a provider at your own discretion.**
