Benham Underpass and Storm Water Pump

Location

Benham Avenue underpass, Harrison St, and Fourth St
Includes neighborhood utility improvements southeast of the Benham water tower.

Description

The Benham Underpass and Storm Water Pump will solve a decades old drainage issue in the Benham South neighborhood. It will also serve as the kick-off to the elimination of one-way streets in downtown.

Scope of Work

A new stormwater lift station will be installed at the Benham water tower property that will drain the neighborhood's rain directly to the St Joseph River. The project will enhance the underpass and change traffic patterns north of the underpass on Benham.

Schedule *(subject to change)*

Phase 1 Construction Starts – March, 2024
Phase 2 Construction Starts – March, 2025
Project Completion – Late 2025

Impacts

Improve drainage throughout the Benham South neighborhood, improve pedestrian and bike connection into downtown, enhance safety, and improve sewer and water network.
